## Freshwater line class records all in the family

HAYWARD — In what was previously an all-male affair, out-door writer Don Vachini and his 3 sons, Chris, Matt and Jason, accumulated over 30 line and tipped class world records over a 9-year span. Not to be left out, however, Don's daughter, Angela Vachini, set about changing that fact, primarily by doing her homework.

With the realization that the National Freshwater Fishing Hall of Fame (HOF), one of 2 organizations which sanctions angling world records, recently added a widely celebrated catch-and-release division, 14-year-old Angela set her sights on the record books in earnest.

First researching, then targeting a trio of vacancies in the rainbow

trout category, she and her dad hiked into the Eastern Sierra's rugged Hoover Wilderness near Bridgeport. There on a small. brush creek, she struck it rich, first landing a bright 16 incher on 15pound line and, a bit later, another heavily-spotted 17 incher on 25pound line. These 2 trophies enabled her to join her father and brothers as world record holders. Together the fishin' Vachini's family ledger currently totals an amazing 38 line or tippet marks in golden, brook and rainbow trout species!
